The financial report over 2021 is illustrated by the treasurer Silvio Pagliara and examined by the Assembly. The report covers different years in order to better see the trends, as well as the state of art over 2022 at this moment of the year. The major fluctuations in income and expenditure are caused by the fact that income from projects is irregular and registered in the accountability in the year of reception, while expenditure might be incurred the years after. However, the financial situation according to the treasurer is sound. It is now also possible to renew membership for two years, against an interesting discount. The reports of the auditors Jan Engelen and Susanne Dirks, who confirm the soundness of the accountancy and the overall financial situation, are available and appreciated by the GA. The financial report is approved by the GA as well as the reports of the auditors..

4. AAATE activity report 2021-2022

The president presents the activities, including the projects that AAATE are involved in and the communication strategy, supported by other Board members and the Secretary General for specific activities.

The presentation starts with an overview of the sitting board (2022-2023) on the strategic development of AAATE.

- The doc "Bank Journal 2022" with an overview of all bank transfers for all accounts

Because of strongly fluctuating financial results, a bit of historical background may be useful. Two years ago, the fiscal year 2020 ended with an unusually large positive result (income minus expenses) of € 156 115. This was due to the bookkeeping item "project costs" which depends on expenses to be advanced for running AAATE's European projects and the EU advance payments which are received on unpredictable dates.

In 2021 AAATE had an income of € 60 800, and the costs amounted to € 110 991, mainly project and management costs.

In 2022 AAATE had a total income of € 104 310 (membership fees, the 2022 Lecco Conference and the European project funding). Total expenses amounted to €115 500. Besides the European project costs, the main expenses of AAATE consisted of the wage of the secretary-general and the costs of secretarial support.

The total assets of the AAATE at the end of 2022 amount to € 209 216. The bank account showed a positive balance of € 207 396 (cf. document "Account Statement 31122") The difference with the assets figure is due to a couple of membership debtors.

Hereby I gladly respond to the request to review the financial report for 2022.

The Financial Report shows a net turnover for 2022 of € 104.309,73. The total expenses amounted to € 115.499,98. This results in an annual result of € -11.190,25 for the fiscal year 2022.

The negative balance for 2022 is due to time-delayed payments in the projects. The ENTELIS+ project was finished in 2022, four further projects (two H2020, two Erasmus+) are still going on.

The total AAATE's assets amounted to € 209.216,10 at the end of 2022. As of December 31, 2022, the account 32100-229488 was balanced with € 207.396,10. The difference between assets and account balance (€ 1.820) is mainly due to unpaid membership fees.

After careful review, I conclude that the 2022 financial report is accurate and reflects the true financial position of the AAATE at the end of the year 2022.
